Bond Project and Facility Update: Spring 2024

As we continue our journey through the latest phase of our bond projects, I would like to take a moment to reflect on the path that has led us to this point. In 2021, our community made a pivotal decision by approving the bond proposal, demonstrating unwavering support for our vision of inspiring and empowering endless opportunities for every individual within the Clinton community.

Since the passing of the 2021 Bond, extensive planning and effort have been dedicated to designing and engineering the necessary improvements to our district's existing facilities. Following the approval and sale of the bonds, our district representatives have diligently collaborated with architects and construction managers to meticulously plan various construction and renovation phases, ensuring the effective execution of our projects.

In January 2022, the Board of Education approved the final bids for the DPP Preschool addition. This marked a significant milestone in our journey. Subsequently, construction commenced in Spring 2022 and was successfully completed in early 2023. It brings me great joy to share that the Preschool welcomed students on January 23, 2023, marking the beginning of a new chapter for our youngest learners. The new classrooms and multipurpose space, a testament to our commitment to providing top-notch educational facilities for our students.

Project Highlights:

- Elementary School:
 - The classroom doors and hardware project, initiated during winter break, has reached its final stages and is nearing completion. Supported by grant funding in addition to the bond money, this project underscores our dedication to enhancing safety and security within our school premises. We are proud to announce the installation of safety film on exterior doors and windows, further strengthening our efforts to enhance safety and security throughout our school facilities.
- High School Addition:
 - Progress on the high school addition continues despite ongoing supply chain delays. We remain hopeful for completion by Spring Break of 2025, with our teams working diligently to mitigate any challenges. The exterior walls are complete, and roof work and inside work are progressing steadily. Significant cement work is being conducted, including walls, roofs, insulation, plumbing, and

electrical work. Construction activities are also underway inside, focusing on the 19 classrooms and then a special education wing with a classroom and a life skills classroom.

- The replacement of the aging HVAC system with Roof Top Units (RTU) is completed and running smoothly. Ongoing tweaks are being made to optimize its efficiency.
- The upgrade of the fire alarm system in the existing high school has been installed and will become operational upon the completion of the new addition in summer 2024, seamlessly integrating the systems.
- Additionally, the installation of a new, more secure middle school office entrance (current high school student entrance) will begin in summer 2024.

As we move forward, committees will be established to focus on finalizing interior details and selecting furnishings, technological equipment, and other essentials for the new addition. Simultaneously, committees at the elementary level will evaluate and upgrade furnishings as necessary, ensuring a conducive learning environment for all students.

Your ongoing support and patience are invaluable as we strive to create exceptional learning environments for our students. Together, we are shaping a brighter future for the Clinton Community Schools.
