Limited Schools of Choice Program

Date:	December 17, 2024
Background Information:	At a regular meeting of the Clinton Community Schools' Board of Education held on December 16, 2024, the Board of Education acted to adopt the recommendation of the Superintendent that Clinton Community Schools will not open the School of Choice program for the second semester of the 2024-2025 school year.
Reason:	Clinton Community Schools is prioritizing the completion of critical projects, including facility improvements, grade-level realignment, and other district initiatives. To maintain manageable class sizes and ensure quality educational programming, the district has decided not to accept new School of Choice students for the second semester of the 2024-2025 school year.
Schools Impacted:	All Clinton Community Schools buildings
Grades Impacted:	All grades, Young Fives through 12th
Application Period:	There will be no application period for School of Choice for the second semester of the 2024-2025 school year.
Application Form:	Since Clinton Community Schools is not accepting School of Choice applications for the second semester of the 2024-2025 school year, no application form will be available.
Application Submission:	Not applicable, as School of Choice enrollment is not open for the second semester of the 2024-2025 school year.
Eligible Nonresident Students:	Not applicable for the second semester of the 2024-2025 school year, as School of Choice enrollment is not open.

Frequently Asked Questions Related to the Limited Schools of Choice Program

- 1. Will Clinton Community Schools accept School of Choice applications for the second semester of the 2024-2025 school year?**

No, Clinton Community Schools will not be opening School of Choice for the second semester of the 2024-2025 school year. This decision complies with Michigan's Schools of Choice law, which allows districts the flexibility to determine their participation and enrollment periods.

- 2. When will the district consider reopening School of Choice?**

The district will review its enrollment capacity and facilities upon completion of current projects and realignments. We are hopeful that School of Choice enrollment will reopen for the 2025-2026 school year.

3. **Why has the district decided not to open School of Choice for the second semester?**

This decision allows the district to focus on completing critical infrastructure and program improvements, ensuring a high-quality educational experience for all students while managing class sizes effectively.

4. **What should families interested in School of Choice do in the meantime?**

Families are encouraged to monitor the district's website and communications for updates regarding the reopening of the School of Choice program for future academic years.
